With the growth of the elderly population, elder law has become one of today's fastest-growing specialty areas of law practice. Elder law attorneys serve the needs and represent the interests of elderly clients covering a wide range of issues associated with the aging process. Elder law covers many other areas such as health care, social security, estate planning and trusts, financial, tax and retirement planning, civil rights and consumer protection.
