Minimum standards for network access:

Pentium 4 1GHz CPU
256MB RAM
20 GB hard drive
10/100 Ethernet Adapter
or
IEEE 802.11b compatible wireless ethernet PCMCIA Adapter (or built in adapter)
Windows 2000

Suggested laptop configuration:

Intel Core 2 Duo 2.80GHz CPU
2GB RAM
200GB hard drive
Built in IEEE 802.11b/g compatible Ethernet device
Windows Vista Home Premium

Suggested software standards:

All required software will be available to students in the computer lab located in the library. However, lab use will be restricted due to scheduling of the lab room. Therefore it is suggested that students purchase a personal copy of Microsoft Office and Adobe Acrobat for their laptop to insure availability. It will also be necessary for all computers to have virus protection before they will be granted network access.

Apple computers can be used throughout the law school for Internet access and word processing, and exams can be taken through the utility of Boot Camp and a separately purchased copy of Windows.
